

Marie-Noelle DUQUENNE (NTYKEN), Doctor of Mathematical Economics and Econometrics (University of Paris X), researcher at the Foundation for Mediterranean Studies (Athens) and then Professor of Statistics and Econometric Methods of Spatial Analysis at the Department of Planning and Regional Development of the Polytechnic School of the University of Thessaly. Since 1999, she is a permanent member of the Laboratory of Demographic and Social Analysis of the University of Athens. She is also member of the International Scientific Association Demobalk and since 2011, member of the Board of Directors of the Union. She was visiting researcher at the National Institute of Demography of France (INED) for three months in 2011.

She has participated as scientific partner and / or scientific manager in over 60 research projects funded by national and international organizations both in Greece as well as in African and Balkan countries. She is author of a large number of papers in scientific journals, collective volumes, international conference proceedings dealing with issues such as (a) population and socio-economic evolutions / mutations at regional and local scale (with their spatial dimensions), (b) Attractiveness of territorial units with emphasis on potential of attraction of new population groups and economic activities in the countryside (c) internal migration and forms of mobility, (d) approach and measurement of socio-economic inequalities.
